File Number: Queen Charlotte RCMP weekly media update January 30, 2012

During the week from January 23rd to January 29th, 2012, Queen Charlotte RCMP responded to 13 calls for service. Some of these were:

- On January 24th, at 1430hrs, Queen Charlotte RCMP were called to a residential tenancy issue on Park Rd in Sandspit
- On January 25th, while on routine patrol, a Queen Charlotte RCMP officer observed an adult male walking out of the liquor store with a flat of beer. The male was known to be on bail with conditions not to possess alcohol. The suspect was arrested. During the arrest a small quantity of marihuana was also discovered. The suspect had a bail hearing conducted and was released to appear in court at a later date.
- On January 28th at 2045hrs, Queen Charlotte RCMP received a complaint of youths drinking in the 600blk of Oceanview Dr. Police attended and spoke with the youths. No alcohol was noted.
- On January 29th at 0600, Queen Charlotte RCMP responded to a suspicious incident in the 500blk of Skidegate Heights where a male was trying to gain access to a residence. Upon arrival it was learned that an intoxicated neighbour had been trying to get into the house in error.
