During the week from April 18th to April 24th 2011 inclusive, the Queen Charlotte RCMP responded to 16 calls for service. Some of which are summarized below:

April 18, RCMP responded to a complaint of a single motor vehicle collision on Hwy 16 near Second Beach. Upon attendance the vehicle was gone. The owner was later located and it was determined that the vehicle had gone off the road after hitting a patch of ice. Minor injuries and damage were sustained in the collision.

April 19, RCMP received a complaint of a disturbance in Sandspit. Police investigated and subsequently arrested a female for Uttering Threats. She was released on Conditions to later appear in Court.

April 19, RCMP received a complaint of a male having seizures outside on Forestry Hill. Police attended and assisted BC Ambulance with the transport to hospital in Queen Charlotte.

April 20, RCMP received a complaint of uttering threats in Skidegate. Police are investigating.

April 21, RCMP received a complaint that some youths had started an excavator that was parked at the Skidegate Community Hall. Police are investigating.

April 22, RCMP responded to a domestic disturbance complaint in Skidegate. Police investigated and subsequently arrested a male for Uttering Threats, he was released on Conditions to later appear in Provincial Court.

April 23, RCMP received a complaint of a theft of furniture from a vacant residence in Skidegate. Police responded and located the parties involved and interviewed. The property was returned to the owner. This matter is still under investigation.
