File Number: Queen Charlotte RCMP weekly media update

During the week from August 29th to September 4th, 2011, Queen Charlotte RCMP responded to 26 calls for service. Some of these were:

- On August 29th at 1630hrs, RCMP attended to the 600 block of Mountainview Way in Skidegate for a well-being check.
- On August at 0900hrs, RCMP attended to Skedans with representatives from Parks Canada and the Haida Nation for a complaint of found human remains that were determined to be historical in nature.
- On August 30th, RCMP encountered a dirt bike riding illegally on the road. The operator was stopped and informed of the legal issues with operating on the road.
- On August 30th at 0100hrs, RCMP received a complaint of a loud party in Skidegate heights.
- On August 30th at 0900hrs, RCMP responded to a complaint of mischief to the Skidegate Health Center where someone had damaged the garden overnight.
- On August 31st at 1545hrs, RCMP received a complaint of an assault which occurred on the BC Ferry from Prince Rupert.
- On August 31st at 1630hrs, RCMP responded to a complaint of a possible capsized boat in Skidegate Inlet. The boat turned out to be loose logs.
- On September 2nd at 0330hrs, RCMP responded to a complaint of an assault where a male was hit with a beer bottle outside of Howlers.
- On September 2nd, at 0353hrs, RCMP received a complaint of a loud party in the 500 block of Mountainview Way in Skidegate.
