File Number: Queen Charlotte RCMP weekly update

During the week from August 22nd to August 28th, 2011, Queen Charlotte RCMP responded to 18 calls for service. Some of these were:

- On August 22nd at 1450hrs, Queen Charlotte RCMP received a report of overdue fishermen who did not return as expected the evening before. Prior to activating Search & Rescue, they returned after spending the night intentionally on the west coast.
- On August 22nd at 1500hrs, Queen Charlotte RCMP received a complaint of a Hit & Run on Copper Bay Rd in Sandspit
- On August 23rd at 1400hrs, Queen Charlotte RCMP attended to a complaint of an intoxicated male at the Farmers Market. Police attended and dealt with the individual at that location.
- On August 25th at 1430hrs, RCMP received a report of a missing mountain bike. A dark grey Norco Pinnacle with Green writing, 22" frame is missing from ALM Elementary in Sandspit.
- On August 25th at 1850hrs, RCMP received a complaint of uttering threats.
- On August 25th at 1900hrs, RCMP responded to a dispute between tenants of a common building in the 500 block of 2nd. The incident was mediated by police.
- On August 26th at 1330hrs, RCMP responded to a complaint of an intoxicated male in the 200 block of 2nd. A local resident was spoken with and sent on his way home.
- On August 26th at 2140hrs, RCMP responded to the docks where someone had discharged several flares.
- On August 28th, RCMP generated a police file for public mischief, related to a report of Hit & Run in Sandspit on August 22nd. Public mischief is a criminal offence under s.140 of the Criminal Code, generally related to reporting a false incident to police. Queen Charlotte RCMP would like to thank the citizens of Sandspit for their assistance with the initial report and the subsequent information. As a result we will be recommending charges of Public Mischief to the local Crown Counsel.
