File Number: Weekly media briefing

During the week from Feb 15 - Feb 21, Queen Charlotte RCMP responded to 9 calls for service.

10-92 - On 2010-02-15 RCMP received a complaint of a motor vehicle accident near Halibut Bight. A single vehicle swerved to avoid a deer and went off the road onto the ocean side of the highway. The driver attended to the hospital for examination and was released. The vehicle was towed before the tide came in.

10-93 - On 2010-02-15 RCMP received a complaint of an attempted Break & Enter into a property in Sandspit. No entry was gained.

10-95 - On 2010-02-16 at 2330 RCMP received a complaint of Assault in Skidegate. An adult male, who is a resident of Queen Charlotte, was arrested for assault and held until sober, then released to appear in court at a later date.

10-96 - On 2010-02-17 at 2200hrs RCMP attended to a complaint of a domestic dispute in Queen Charlotte. An adult male was arrested for assault and held in cells until he was released to appear in court at a later date.

10-97 - On 2010-02-18 RCMP issued a Sandspit resident a notice of suspension as requested by the Superintendent of Motor Vehicles.

10-98 - On 2010-02-18 at 1545, an intoxicated adult male attended to the RCMP detachment. In the parking lot he became belligerent & started to cause a disturbance. He was arrested & held in custody until he was sober.

10-100 - On 2010-02-19 at 2240hrs RCMP encountered a minor with open liquor on Bay st. The liquor was seized and the youth was issued a ticket as a result.
