During the week from February 21st to February 27th, Queen Charlotte RCMP responded to 15 calls for service. Some of these were:

- On February 21st, RCMP responded to a complaint of harassing phone calls on 4th Ave in Queen Charlotte
- On February 21st, RCMP responded to a complaint of a domestic assault on Oceanview Drive in Queen Charlotte. A local male was arrested and released on conditions to appear in court
- On February 22nd, RCMP received a complaint of an intoxicated male in the area of the City Center. Patrols in the area were unsuccessful
- On February 23rd, RCMP received a complaint of a theft of cash that occurred at QCSS. A student had monies stolen when left in the changeroom during gym class.
- On February 24th, RCMP received a complaint of threats related to a domestic disturbance earlier in the week.
- On February 25th RCMP received a complaint of an intoxicated male in the 3100 block of Oceanview Dr. Police attended, spoke with the individual and sent him on his way.
- On February 27th, RCMP received a complaint of an assault in progress in the 500 block of Skidegate Heights. Police attended. A local resident was arrested for assault and released to appear in court at a later date.
- On February 27th a vehicle was stopped on Hwy 16 near the co-op. The driver was found to be suspended and the vehicle was impounded for 7 days as a result. The driver was issued an appearance notice for court.
