During the week from February 7th to February 13th, 2011, Queen Charlotte RCMP responded to 15 calls for service. Some of these are as follows:

- On Feb 7th, Queen Charlotte RCMP received a report of a vehicle being taken without consent. The owner had parked the vehicle on Oceanview overnight with the keys inside. When he returned the next day to pick it up it was in a different location with evidence of it being taken through the bush where it suffered minor damages.
- On Feb 7th, Queen Charlotte RCMP received a complaint of a theft of a wallet from an unlocked vehicle in the 500 block of Skidegate Heights.
- On February 9th at 1445hrs, Queen Charlotte RCMP responded to a disturbance in the City Centre parking lot where two individuals were having a dispute. The parties were spoken to and sent on separate ways.
