During the week from July 19th to July 25th, 2010, Queen Charlotte RCMP responded to 19 calls for service. Some of these were:

- On July 19th, RCMP responded to a complaint of a B&E in Skidegate heights where downriggers and liquor was stolen.
- On July 20th, at 2000hrs, RCMP received a noise complaint on Spruce rd in Sandspit.
- On July 22nd, RCMP receive a report of a bag of marihuana being found near the airport in Sandspit.
- On July 23rd, RCMP received a complaint of uttering a forged document at the Credit Union. Charges are being forwarded against a local youth.
- On July 23rd at 1830hrs RCMP received a complaint of a male causing a disturbance at Causeway & Wharf St. Patrols were negative.
