File Number: Queen Charlotte - Weekly update

During the week from July 4th to July 10th, 2011, Queen Charlotte RCMP responded to 27 calls for service. Some of these were:

- On July 4th at 1200hrs, RCMP received a complaint of a stolen wallet from a business in the 2600 block of Oceanview Drive.
- On July 4th at 2130hrs, RCMP attended to a business in the 3300 block of Oceanview drive for an intoxicated male causing a disturbance.
- On July 5th at 2100hrs, RCMP attended to a complaint of an intoxicated male in the 3300block of Oceanview Drive.
- On July 6th, RCMP received a complaint on 2nd ave in Skidegate of people parking on the road to walk to a nearby drug house.
- On July 6th at 000hrs, RCMP received a complaint of shots from the area of Jewell Island. Police attendance revealed campers with fireworks.
- On July 6th at 1100hrs, RCMP attended to a complaint of mischief where two cars had a tire slashed each while parked in their driveway in the 500blk of Mountainview Way.
