During the week from May 17th to May 23rd, Queen Charlotte RCMP responded to 12 calls for service. Some of these are as follows:

10-302 - RCMP received a complaint of mischief at the school in Sandspit.

10-303 - RCMP received a complaint of fraudulent use of a debit card.

10-304 - RCMP received a complaint of loose dogs in Skidegate. The matter is being referred to the Skidegate Band Council for action under their bylaw

10-306 - RCMP received a complaint of a possibly suicidal male in Skidegate. The male was spoken with and assessed.

10-307 - RCMP received a complaint of speeding vehicles in Sandspit.

10-310 - While patrolling in Sandspit, RCMP stopped a vehicle for speeding and seized open liquor from the occupants of the vehicle. The occupants were issued violation tickets for speeding and possessing open liquor in a vehicle.
