File Number: Queen Charlotte RCMP weekly media update Nov 7, 2011

During the week from October 31, 2011 to November 7, 2011, Queen Charlotte RCMP generated 23 files for investigation. Some of these were:

- On October 31st, 2011, Queen Charlotte RCMP received a complaint of ongoing domestic abuse. RCMP forwarded charges to crown counsel and obtain a warrant for the suspects arrest.
- On October 31st, at 1300hrs, Queen Charlotte RCMP received a complaint of a found aluminum boat near Skidegate landing. The owner can contact RCMP for more information.
- On November 1st at 0100hrs, Queen Charlotte RCMP received a complaint of a loud party in the 100blk of 3rd Ave in Skidegate.
- On November 1st at 0110hrs, Queen Charlotte RCMP received a complaint from an adult male that he had broken into a business in Tlell. Police attended and located the male inside the business. He was arrested and returned to QCC where he was held until sober, then released with documents to appear in court.
- On November 1st at 1130hrs, Queen Charlotte RCMP received a found bike at the detachment. An orange Norco mountain bike was discovered in a ditch on Oceanview. The owner can come to the RCMP to recover same.
- On November 2nd at 1700hrs, Queen Charlotte RCMP seized several marihuana plants from a residence in Tlell as part of a drug investigation.
- On November 3rd at 1600hrs, Queen Charlotte RCMP received a complaint of a accident where a vehicle collided with an unattended vehicle in the 3200blk of Wharf St.
- On November 4th at 1100hrs, Queen Charlotte RCMP received a complain of mischief in the 400blk of Beach Rd in Sandspit where a neighbour damaged a structure which spans both properties.
- On November 5th at 1700hrs, Queen Charlotte RCMP responded to a domestic assault in Sandspit which had occurred the night previous. A male was arrested and released on documents to appear in court.
