During the week from Feb 22 - Feb 28, Queen Charlotte RCMP responded to 15 calls for service

10-101 - On Feb 22 at 1353hrs RCMP received a complaint of an erratic driver in Skidegate. Patrols for the vehicle were negative.

10-102 - On Feb 22 at 1553hrs, RCMP received a complaint of uttering threats in Skidegate. Police attended and cleared up a misunderstanding between the parties

10-104 - On Feb 23, RCMP received a complaint of a stolen licence plate. The complainant advised the plate had been stolen sometime in the past 10yrs.

10-105 - On Feb 24th at 2130, RCMP received a complaint of an intoxicated male walking into traffic on Hwy 16 in Skidegate. Police attended and the male was arrested under the Liquor Control & Licensing Act. He was released without charges when he was no longer a danger to himself or others.

10-106 - On Feb 24 at 2230hrs, RCMP responded to a complaint of uttering threats on 4th ave in Skidegate. Police attended and difused the situation. The complainant was not cooperative with pursuing charges.

10-109 - On Feb 25 at 1430hrs, RCMP received a complaint of an intoxicated male, on the docks, in need of medical attention. RCMP attended with BC Ambulance who transported the male to the hospital for treatment.

10-110 - On Feb 27th at 0348hrs, RCMP received a complaint of a fight in Skidegate heights. The fight broke up without incident.

10-113 - On Feb 27 at 2103hrs, RCMP received a call of several youths throwing items at a complainants window in Skidegate heights.
