During the week from October 3rd to October 9th, 2011, Masset RCMP responded to 31 calls for service. Some of these were:

- On October 3rd at 0840hrs, RCMP attended to an abandoned vehicle in the 2000blk of Harrison Ave
- On October 3rd at 1500hrs, RCMP received a complaint of a vicious dog in the area of Maple and Orr street. The matter was referred to the village for action under their bylaw.
- On October 3rd at 1600hrs, RCMP received a complaint of a harassing phone call.
- On October 4th at 1800hrs, RCMP received a complaint of a disturbance in the 100blk of Raven Ave in Old Masset. Police attended. a local female was arrested and held until sober.
