

VILLAGE OF QUEEN CHARLOTTE

BYLAW NO. 37-2010

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 8-2006, A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A LOCAL AREA WATER SUPPLY AND DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM SERVICE

WHEREAS the Village of Queen Charlotte Letters Patent dated June 28, 2005 established a local area service for water supply and distribution services;

AND WHEREAS section 14.4 of the Village of Queen Charlotte Letters Patent required the Village of Queen Charlotte to adopt a bylaw with respect to the water supply and distribution local area service and furthermore to describe in such bylaw the same part of the municipality to be benefited as described in *Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District, By-Law No. 90-1980*;

AND WHEREAS the Village of Queen Charlotte adopted "Local Area Water Supply and Distribution System Service Establishing Bylaw No. 8, 2006" and that bylaw inaccurately describes the service area required to be benefited under section 14.4 of the Village of Queen Charlotte Letters Patent;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Queen Charlotte in open meeting assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Citation

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Local Area Water Supply and Distribution System Service Establishing Bylaw No. 8, 2006, Amendment Bylaw No. 37, 2010".

Service Area Boundaries Amended

2. Section 3 of Local Area Water Supply and Distribution System Service Establishing Bylaw No. 8, 2006 is deleted and replaced with the following:

3. The local service area for the service established under section 2 (the

“Service Area”) has the boundaries described in Schedule “A” attached to this bylaw, and a map showing the approximate location of the boundaries is in Schedule “B” attached to this bylaw.

Schedules Amended

3. Schedule “A” of Local Area Water Supply and Distribution System Service Establishing Bylaw No. 8, 2006 is deleted and replaced with Schedule “A” as attached to this bylaw.
4. Schedule “B” of Local Area Water Supply and Distribution System Service Establishing Bylaw No. 8, 2006 is deleted and replaced with Schedule “B” as attached to this bylaw.

SCHEDULE "A"

Commencing at the southeast corner of Lot 15, Queen Charlotte District, being a point on the natural highwater mark of Bearskin Bay on the northerly shore thereof; thence northerly along the easterly boundary of said Lot 15 to the northeast corner thereof; thence westerly along the northerly boundaries of Lots 15, 16A and 16 to the northwest corner of said Lot 16; thence southerly along the westerly boundary of Lot 16 to the northeast corner of Lot 1314; thence westerly and southerly along the northerly and westerly boundaries of Lot 1314 to the southwest corner thereof being a point on the aforesaid natural highwater mark of Bearskin Bay on the northerly shore thereof; thence in a general easterly direction along the said natural highwater mark at the aforesaid southeast corner of Lot 15, being the point of commencement.
