

**VILLAGE OF QUEEN CHARLOTTE
BYLAW NO. 46-2010**

**A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW 4, 2005, A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH
OFFICERS POSITIONS**

WHEREAS Section 146 of the *Community Charter* empowers Council, by bylaw, to establish officer positions and to establish the powers, duties and responsibilities of such officers;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Village of Queen Charlotte in an open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

CITATION

1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "A Bylaw to Amend the Village of Queen Charlotte Officers Bylaw No. 4-2005".
2. Section 2 is amended by adding the following as an additional officer position of the Municipality:

(d) approving officer
3. The following new Section 6 is hereby added:

6. The powers, duties and responsibilities of the Approving Officer are the functions assigned to the approving officer under the Land Title Act, the Strata Property Act, the Local Government Act and the Real Estate Development Marketing Act.
4. Section 6, Oath of Office, is renumbered as section 7.




