

**VILLAGE OF QUEEN CHARLOTTE**

**BYLAW NO. 22-2008**

**A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 9-2006, A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A  
LOCAL AREA SEWAGE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICE**

**WHEREAS** under section 14.2 of the Village of Queen Charlotte Letters Patent dated June 28, 2005, a local area service was established for a sewage collection and disposal service, effective December 31, 2005;

**AND WHEREAS** through inadvertence, the service area boundaries for the local service were described as the boundaries of the municipality of the Village of Queen Charlotte instead of the boundaries of the specified area established by Skeena-Queen Charlotte Regional District Bylaw No. 91-1980, as directed by section 14.4 of the Village of Queen Charlotte Letters Patent dated June 28, 2005;

**AND WHEREAS** section 14.4 of the Village of Queen Charlotte Letters Patent dated June 28, 2005 states that sections 211(1)(a), (b) and (c) of the *Community Charter* were not applicable to the adoption of Bylaw No. 9, and section 27(4) of the *Interpretation Act* extends those exemptions to an amending bylaw as section 137 of the *Community Charter* does not apply to a bylaw adopted under the authority of Letters Patent;

**AND WHEREAS** the sewage collection and disposal service area has been treated for all purposes as if it were the original specified area and the Council of the Village of Queen Charlotte wishes to amend Bylaw No. 9-206 to correct the error in the description of the local service area boundaries;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Council of the Village of Queen Charlotte in open meeting assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**Citation**

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Local Area Sewage Collection and Disposal Service Establishing Bylaw No. 9, 2006, Amendment Bylaw No. 22-2008".

**Service Area Boundaries Amended**

2. Section 3 of Local Area Sewage Collection and Disposal Service Establishing Bylaw No. 9, 2006 is deleted and the following section 3 is substituted for it:

**Service Area Boundaries**

3. The Service Area comprises the land more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached to this bylaw and the boundaries of the Service Area are shown in red on the map attached to this bylaw as Schedule "B".

**Schedules**

3. Schedules "A" and "B" attached to this bylaw are also attached to Local Area Sewage Collection and Disposal Service Establishing Bylaw No. 9, 2006 and form part of and are enforceable in the same manner as those bylaws.

**SCHEDULE "A"**

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Commencing at the southeast corner of Lot 15, Queen Charlotte District, being a point on the natural highwater mark of Bearskin Bay on the northerly shore thereof; thence northerly along the easterly boundary of said Lot 15 to the northeast corner thereof; thence westerly along the northerly boundaries of Lots 15, 16A and 16 to the northwest corner of said Lot 16; thence southerly along the westerly boundary of Lot 16 to the northeast corner of Lot 1314; thence westerly and southerly along the northerly and westerly boundaries of Lot 1314 to the southwest corner thereof being a point on the aforesaid natural highwater mark of Bearskin Bay on the northerly shore thereof; thence in a general easterly direction along the said natural highwater mark at the aforesaid southeast corner of Lot 15, being the point of commencement.
