Interlocking Paving:

This durable surfacing comes in a variety of shapes and colours.



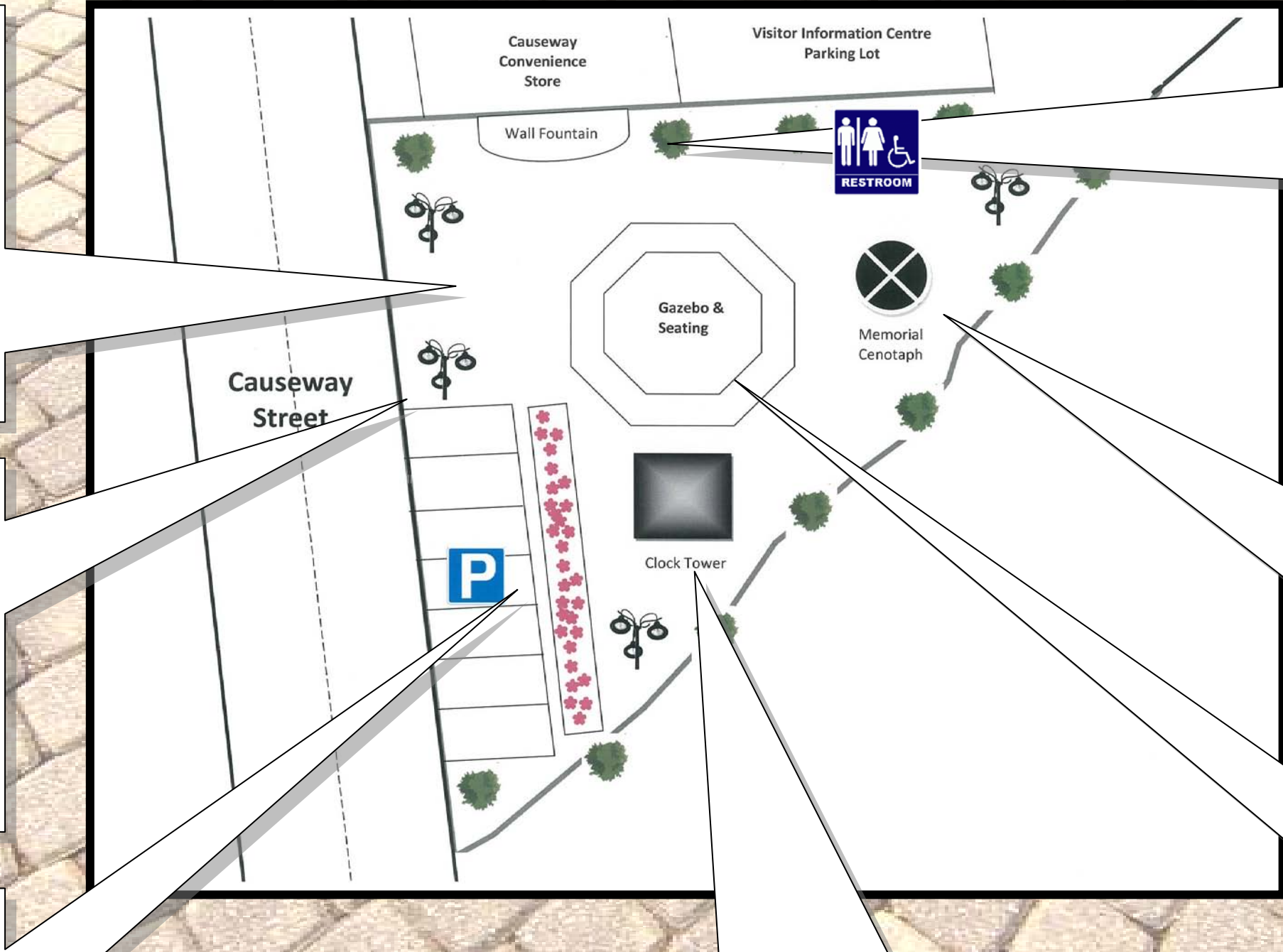
Street Lamps:

Iron Street Lamps would provide lighting, aesthetics, and somewhere to hang flower baskets in the summer.




Community Gardens:

Flower beds and hanging baskets would beautify the area and require volunteer hours. Many communities host Memorial Gardens that are dedicated to a deceased member of the community and are maintained by friends and family. Memorial benches are another idea.



Water Fountain:

Water fountains are another common element of town squares, either free standing or against an existing wall. Some are designed as play areas for children during the warmer months.



Memorial Cenotaph:

This could be relocated from in front of the RCMP building or a new one could be erected. A plaque with the names of all local men who died during the wars could be added- as well as recognition to all those lost at sea. This would be the new location for Remembrance Day ceremonies. These monuments often include a statue.




Other Possible Ideas:

- A place of commerce for outside vendors such as farmers markets.
- Picnic benches / somewhere to sit and eat.
- Iron chain posts that can be removed to provide access to VIC parking lot.
- An information board showing the horizon and inlet features with descriptions and points of interest and names of islands, old villages, etc.

Clock Tower:

Clock towers are the focus points for many town squares. Some can include staircases providing a vantage point for enjoying your surroundings.



Gazebo:

A large gazebo would provide an entertainment platform for bands and MC's during community events. It would be surrounded by seating and have a power supply.
