We are currently doing the paperwork that is required under legislation.

We will be adding new registrations to the voters list. Unfortunately, there was a glitch on the updated voters list – some names were not carried forward when we updated the 2011 list.

There were some voters voicing an objection to the requirement to present ID. It is a requirement under the Local Government Act that all voters present two pieces of ID to obtain a ballot, even if their name is on the voters list. This requirement is to enable the polling clerk to verify the voters identity. This is not unique to municipal elections.
