

The Village of Queen Charlotte is pleased to announce that the Boat Launch Upgrade Project has been awarded to Berg-Mac Industries Ltd. of Queen Charlotte.

BREAKWATER CONSTRUCTION

Construction of the breakwater will be completed between May 15 and July 3, 2016. During this time the contractor will make reasonable efforts to keep the boat launch available for launching vessels, however truck and trailer parking will not be available. This is because the parking area is needed for staging the concrete lock blocks and other material required for the construction. We will also be relocating the entrance gates to the Helipad and creating a second road access and gate in the NW corner.

It is possible that complete closure of the boat launch may be required during the construction and we will try and give as much notice to boaters as possible.

NEW RAMP CONSTRUCTION

Assuming there are no delays in the first part of the project, we anticipate construction of the new concrete ramp will be completed from July 3 to 30, 2016. During this time truck and trailer parking will continue to be unavailable. We hope to have brief periods when the boat launch will be available for launching vessels. Again, we will try to give as much notice to boat users as possible.

While we understand that boat launch users will be inconvenienced during the construction of the new breakwater and boat launch ramp, we hope that everyone will keep the long term benefits in mind.
